## Mission Update Rose Hill/SafeHouse Ministries

Thank you for making a difference in the lives of homeless men and women through the ministries at Rose Hill UMC and SafeHouse. Along with the Clothing Bank and Food Relief, St. Paul now participates with a Telemedicine and Medicine program that is co-sponsored with MercyMed. This new program enables our volunteers to help MercyMed assess residents of Safehouse with some of their medical-physical needs. Under MercyMed's care, the SafeHouse residents are able to be treated by a physician and participate in a prescription drug assistance program that helps many homeless with the cost of generic medication that are vital to their health.

The Clothing Bank at Rose Hill continues to provide much needed clothing to hundreds of homeless individuals. Currently we serve over 100 people each week. Likewise, St Paul, along with many other local churches, continues to provide weekly meals for over 150 homeless individuals in our community. Our goal is to not only care for their physical needs but to treat everyone with dignity and respect.
