St. Paul For All Day Service Sunday!



Mark the date on your calendar and make plans to be a part of our 10th Annual SP4A Service Sunday! On the morning of Sunday October 20, we will once again team up with Rise Against Hunger to put together nutrition/meal packs for people around the world plagued with starvation and malnutrition. Over the last two years, St. Paul has packed and provided close to 60,000 meals for food insecure communities as far away as Madagascar, making sure that everyone has access to at least one meal a day--helping the hungry children in these areas receive the vitamins their bodies and minds need to grow. This year, our goal is to pack at least another 25,000 meals, but we need YOUR help to do this! Just one hour of your time on St. Paul For All Day might literally save somebody's life. Plus, it is a great way for St. Paul families to serve together, from the "littles" to the "grands!"

To address the needs of the food insecure in our own community, we are teaming up with Wynnton Neighborhood Network to provide Essential Needs Meal Bags and Holiday Meal Bags for the people the network serves. Grocery bags with shopping lists and statistics on the local hunger crisis will be available for pick up at St Paul, our prayer being that our St. Paul families will shop together, using this as a teaching moment for their own children about those in need, or even for other customers in the grocery store who might wonder what you are doing with your list! The cost to put together a bag is nominal -- around \$16.00 for an essentials bag and \$25.00 for a holiday bag, but the value of our families serving together, to feed families in need . . . Priceless!!

Our goal is to provide at least 50 bags of each type to WNN. Come on St. Paul! We can do this...Easy Peasy!! 
ST. PAUL HAPPENINGS!

In today's lessons for children, God appears to Abraham and tells him to pack up his family and belongings and travel to a land that God will show him.

God's call required a lot of trust on Abraham's part. In return for Abraham's trust and obedience, God makes some promises. God will: 1) make Abraham a great nation, 2) bless Abraham, 3) make Abraham's name great, and 4) bless those who bless Abraham (and curse those who curse him). Abraham obeys God, setting in motion events that will continue long after Abraham's life is over.

Blessing is a key theme throughout Genesis. A blessing is an approval or affirmation. Parents, take this lesson as an opportunity to bless your children and remind them that they are special. Also, use the questions in "Talk About It" to discuss how God blessed Abraham and Sarah.

HOW TO HELP THOSE AFFECTED BY HELENE samaritanspurse.org

Helene tore through western North Carolina, dumping extreme rainfall (up to 2 feet) and causing terrible flash flooding. Some parts of the area are in ruins. We are providing relief in the mountains of Watauga County, North Carolina—home to Samaritan's Purse international headquarters in the town of Boone. The town and surrounding communities have been particularly hard-hit with toppled trees, flooding, road damage, and a lack of power and water. This response extends to include neighboring counties in North Carolina (Ashe, Avery) and eastern Tennessee (Johnson), and our church base is Alliance Bible Fellowship in Boone.





Samaritan's Purse President Franklin Graham said on Facebook, "Samaritan's Purse responds to help with storms and crises around the world every day, but now the storm has hit in our own backyard. Hurricane Helene slammed western North Carolina and the surrounding area, as well as Georgia and Florida. Homes have been flooded and some even washed away, trees are down, tens of thousands are still without power. We would be grateful for your prayers for all those affected by this storm."
